Monthly report of Darjeeling Animal Shelter



The Darjeeling Animal Shelter has been vaccinating dogs ward-wise. The vaccination camp is for the street and community dogs in Darjeeling and this is the follow-up Programme that is conducted every year by the DAS team. Thanks to Dogs Trust Worldwide for funding this Programme and a big thanks to Darjeeling Municipality for providing two thousand doses of vaccines to the Shelter so that the Shelter could vaccinate all new and old dogs.

The DAS Vet Dr Mihir and team are working relentlessly every day for making this Programme successful. Many wards have been covered by now and a few more to go! The team has also been going door to door, spreading awareness among people, and vaccinating dogs whose owners are underprivileged.





The team has been leaving early for this Programme and locating dogs as well for the ABC Programme. Some dogs are difficult to catch so they are using the catching net and vaccinating them.

The total number of Vaccination done by DAS on November 22 is 1107 in many wards starting from Ward No. 10 to Ward 30.





Adoption

A total of five puppies and a kitten were adopted by locals in the month of November 22





Besides many dogs were rescued by the DAS team. A total of 48 dogs including puppies were rescued. Many of these rescues have been injured dogs, rabies suspected, etc. As Dr. Mihir is working on rabies he is vigilant about rabies cases.

DAS Vehicle was sent for servicing this month. A few of the team members had gone to Siliguri for this purpose.

Manager Furmit says - the Municipality has given permission to DAS for making a new dog pit in the Darjeeling cemetery and digging work has been completed.
